
## ROOM PARENTS NEEDED FOR THE 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR

## Pastor's Pen

Recently I asked the students what makes Catholic schools great and after several answers that would mimic almost any private school (such as dedicated teachers, which is very true, small class sizes, good curriculum), one of the young people answered with, "We get to know Jesus and tell others about Him!"

As a Catholic school, while all the other elements are true, the best and most important thing we offer our students is a relationship with Jesus Christ so that they can share the fruits of this relationship with others. Our students are able to receive Jesus in the Eucharist not only on Sundays with you and the other members of your family but with the school at Mass. Our students are able to read and come to know Jesus through the Bible and the story of our salvation. Our students are able to share this message of God's mercy and love through their outreach (it's why we do our work-a-thon), and through the important ways we bring Jesus to the community.

Our school is amazing! We want to be able to invite other families to come to our school so that we can share with them Jesus.

As summer approaches, I would like to encourage you to ask your child(ren) about their relationship with Jesus, and share ways to share yours with him/her/them. Talk about the blessings you see God giving your child(ren). Share how Jesus helped you when you were experiencing a hard time. Take time to pray together—both the prayers of the tradition as well as more spontaneous prayer.

One of the best ways to pray is to use the acronym PRAY: PRAISE God for the blessings in your life, in your children's life, and in your family. REPENT for any sins that you may have done that hurt your relationships. Pray for ANOTHER person who needs your prayers. Pray for YOURSELF.
